Thank you very much for your letter and comments relating to the SLDC Gambling Policy.

I am pleased to see that the ABB is working closely with local authorities to develop a collaborative approach to ensure working relationships are constructive and information is exchanged in a clear and concise way.

I have noted the comments you have made regarding the draft statement of Gambling policy, in particular:

- Paragraph 11.4 has been changed to reflect paragraph 19.23 of the Gambling Commission Guidance (5th Edition dated September 2015 – updated September 2016).
- Paragraph 2.22 – we believe that the policy infers mandatory default conditions are sufficient to ensure operation is reasonably consistent with the licensing objectives, therefore no change has been made in this respect.
- Paragraph 16.4 – no change has been made as we believe the policy infers the application may be required amend the application to reflect default operating hours.
