I write further to your letter of 12th July in relation to my vehicle PK57 JYY which is over 10 years of age and as such does not automatically have the right to renewal of its Hackney carriage license.

I confirm my attendance at the Town Hall on 29th July at 10am ,I would have preferred to bring a friend with me as this kind of meeting is not something I am very familiar or comfortable with regrettably due to existing work commitments Miss Hayley Owen is unable to accompany me as she did last year. She is however able to SKYPE or Face time during the Sub Committee meeting should you have any questions for me that were not covered and recorded at the previous meeting 12 months ago. The situation and basis for my renewal request remain exactly the same as in 2018 and so hopefully there will be no further issues to be addressed however I thought it fair to give you advance notice of this point.

I am pleased to report that the small mark (and it was VERY small just a stone chip) has now been repaired in the door of the vehicle. I am further pleased to report the advisory matter raised on the MOT has now been reviewed, in actual fact it was a build up of grease and road debris which prevented the pipe being correctly inspected as opposed to a technical failure of the vehicle.

The vehicle has passed its MOT today and so you will have the latest output from that prior to the meeting on 29th.

In terms of the overall condition of the vehicle clearly it has now completed additional miles but otherwise the overall condition is unchanged. I will ensure it is parked as close as possible to the Town Hall but at this time of year it is not always possible to obtain a space very close , perhaps you would consider "reserving" a space in your visitor allocation if you are definitely wishing to visually review it again this time.
