

Appendix 1 – Proposed Mix of Measures

- SLDC will focus on Owner Occupiers - due to the simple fact there will be less administration involved than rented homes.
- SLDC aim to focus on maximum two localities (although encompass a few wards). These will be identified by lowest performing energy efficiency standards and lower incomes. Focussing on two main areas will be logistically more manageable for the installers and assessors etc. considering the very tight time frame (31.12.21). SLDC is approximately 600 square miles and has a significant rural community as well as having two national parks. We intend to avoid conservation areas and areas in the national parks to minimise administration, planning and other consents. These aspects would be a significant barrier to get works done in the short time frame given.
- SLDC aim to retrofit up to 70 units roughly comprising the following measures;
 - External wall insulation x 53
 - Roof/ loft insulation x 45
 - Cavity wall x 10
 - Glazing (replacement of single glazing only) x 29
 - This scope is likely to change following contact with residents as it will be dependent on take up and formal consideration of individual home requirements and household circumstances. We have yet to identify specific homes/ households potentially suitable/ willing to join the project.
- Eden DC will be using the funding to resource a Full time Equivalent Administrator and a Retrofit co-ordinator
- Consideration will need to be made for things not yet considered at this stage – ‘contingency’ planning.
