



Hi Julie.

In receipt of this representation, I write to you to try to put the community members mind at rest with a description of how we intend to counter act their issues.

Firstly, the representation mentions the playing of loud music. The club have no intention of playing any loud music. Music shall only be played as background music. Any music played will be done so at a volume that would not cause disturbance to the locality. Staff shall regularly walk around the outside of the premises and shall adjust the volume of any music to ensure that it remains at a level which will not cause noise nuisance. As stated in the application all doors & windows will be kept closed to ensure local residents aren't disturbed.
